As per the guide, a petition can be signed by either the ratepayer or by their spouse. There is no alternate billing agreement on file for this person and she is not a member.
507	Juanita Lawson	151 CR 161	Juanita Lawson is the member. She signed the petition. Her son, Daniel Adams, also signed the petition on a different page and listed the same address. There is only supposed to be one signature per household and he is not a spouse.
656	Robin Brown	293 FM 2830 S	Robin Brown did not sign the petition. You indicated that Alicia Matthews signed for Robin Brown. I have no alternate billing agreement on file for this person authorizing her to do so, she is not a member, nor is she a spouse.
739	Wayne Krenzke	4281 FM 2830 S	This account is listed under Wayne Krenzke. Delores Kidd who you indicated is his wife signed the petition on one page and Mr. Krenzke signed on another page. There is only supposed to be one signature per household on petition.
134	Geraldine Broussard	1451 FM 2830 S	Mrs. Broussard signed the petition. Her husband John is deceased, but she has a son also named John Broussard who obviously signed the petition as well on another page. There is only supposed to be one signature per household.

Mr. Simien, as per your response letter to PUC on 2/2/18, you indicated you made a request for information. Our board of director's meeting was scheduled to begin at 6 pm on Monday, January 29, 2018. I had no knowledge of a request for information prior to the meeting. Then a few minutes before the meeting started while members were coming in to be seated you mentioned your request for some accounts and addresses to me. I could not interrupt the Board meeting to obtain the records, as well as by law, it was not in writing at that point which I shared with you that I had not received anything in writing at that time.

On January 30, 2018, you sent me an email requesting information that showed 10:46am. You stated that you wanted to mail the information on that same day. A certified copy of a letter written to the PUC was also received from you in the mail at 11:10am that same day. This was not written to Raywood Water Supply as a request for information.

Mr. Simien, I would hope that you would understand that due to my already full load of work I currently have, I too have scheduled work duties and tasks that are already set in place before I receive a request for information. For instance tax documents needed to be mailed out to employees and contractors before January 31, 2018, and that is what I had to focus on that day in addition to scheduled duties and tasks for other employees that require my attention, etc.

I did not even have a full 10 days to respond before you sent in information to the PUC implying that I did not respond. In your 2/2/18 letter to PUC you mentioned that you followed up with a phone call. I did not receive any such phone call nor am I aware that any of my staff spoke to you. Our office hours are Monday thru Friday, 8 am thru 3 pm. My cell phone is also listed as a contact number as well. I can receive text also. If I am unable to speak at the time, I can call you back at my earliest convenience.

I understand the urgency of your request Mr. Simien, but I would also ask that common courtesy be exercised in understanding that I do have a job to do at my office and I try desperately to meet all deadlines to the best of my ability. I also have scheduled doctor appointments that may take me out of the office and one never knows when sickness may be a factor too.

I know that the rate appeal is very important to you, but my job is likewise very important to me. I have been working after hours quiet often until dark on a daily basis during the work week and that is without any extra pay. I would appreciate your cooperation and your belief that I am not holding up matters or being petty as you have mentioned in your emails. I am simply trying to abide by the rules as I understand them.

Utili-Facts

Appealing a Rate Change Decision

Made by a Board of Directors, A City Council, or County Commissioners

If your water or sewer utility¹ changes its rates and you wish to contest the decision, the Public Utility of Texas (PUCT) cannot review the retail rates charged by some types of utilities unless



you file an appeal in the form of a petition. [Texas Water Code (TWC), Section 13.043(b)] Parties to a rate proceeding before the governing body of a municipality may have different appeal rights under TWC, Section 13.043(a).

The petition must be signed by 10 percent of the affected ratepayers (customers) eligible to appeal. (If there are more than 100,000 eligible ratepayers, the petition is valid if at least 10,000 affected ratepayers sign it.)

You must send the petition to the PUCT within a specific period of time, as discussed later in this publication.

Who Can Appeal a Rate Change Decision?

You and your fellow ratepayers may file an appeal if you are served by one of the types of utilities listed below. Also shown is who has original authority to approve or "set" the rates.

Type of Utility	Who sets the rates?
Water Supply Corporations (WSC)	Board of Directors of the WSC
Water District or River Authority	Board of Directors of the District or Authority
Private- or Investor-Owned Utility Operating Inside a City	City Council
City-Owned Utility Serving Customers Outside the City ²	City Council
County within 50 Miles of the U.S Mexico Border Who Sets the Rates?	County Commissioners

Who Can Sign the Petition?

Each person receiving a separate bill is considered a "ratepayer."

However, you can only be considered a single ratepayer regardless of the number of bills you receive. A petition can be signed by


- 1 The term "utility," as used in this publication, corresponds with "retail public utility" as defined by the Texas Water Code, §13.002(19).
- 2 Only ratepayers living outside the city are eligible to appeal. The PUCT does not have jurisdiction to review the rates charged by a city to in-city, retail customers.

either you as the ratepayer, or by your spouse.

What Should the Petition Say?

Each signature page of the petition should include the following:

1. A statement that the petition is an appeal of the decision that set the new rates. In the case of an investor-owned utility (IOU) operating within a city, the petition should state that it appeals the decision that the city made on a rate change requested by the utility.



- 3. The effective date of the rate change and the date the ratepayers were notified of the rate change.
- 4. A statement about why you and your fellow ratepayers are requesting that the PUCT review the decision setting the rates.
- 5. The name and address of an individual or organization that is willing to act as the ratepayers' representative.
- 6. The mailing address and phone number of the utility. In the case of an IOU operating within a city, the petition should also include the name, mailing address, and phone number of the city.

Each ratepayer signing the petition should write legibly and provide the following information:

- · Name.
- Telephone number,
- Street or rural address where the utility service is received (a post office box is not sufficient), and
- Mailing address (if it differs from the address where service is received).

A sample petition appears on the back of this information sheet. This sample should only be used as a guideline. The wording underlined on the sample should be revised as needed for your petition. All the information noted above should be included in your petition.

How is the Petition Filed?

Send a copy of the petition to the utility, and file seven copies of the petition, including the original with the PUCT at:




