Docket No. 47818, Petition of Carma Easton LLC to Amend Creedmoor-Maha Water Supply Corporation's Certificate of Convenience and Necessity in Travis

County by Expedited Release

If the Commission approves the proposed order filed in this docket, I propose modifying the proposed order to make the language consistent with Commission rules and prior Commission orders by making the following changes to findings of fact 1, 3, and 4:

- 1. Carma Easton, owner of an approximately 2,160-acre <u>areatract</u> of land in Travis County, on November 30, 2017, petitioned for the expedited release of <u>a tract of land comprising</u> two parcels of <u>that 2,160-acre area.land</u>. <u>One parcelone that is 20.041 acres</u>, and the other <u>that</u> is 22.027 acres. Both parcels are within CCN No. 11029. The parcels are adjacent to and contiguous with one another and, together, total 42.068 acres.
- 3. The petition indicates that Carma Easton and Creedmoor-Maha have agreed to the compensation Creedmoor-Maha will receive when the 42.068-acre tract acres are is decertified. The petition also indicates that the City of Austin, which Carma Easton intends will provide service to the tractthe alternate service provider, has agreed to the arrangement.
- 4. On December 7, 2017, Order No. 12 was issued setting a deadline for comments on the administrative completeness of the application and notice.

I propose also adding the following finding of fact and footnote:

• In Docket No. 47295, the Commission approved an agreement between Carma Easton and Creedmoor-Maha regarding property rendered useless or valueless by decertification and regarding compensation for that property. The agreement provided a settlement for seven specified expedited-release dockets. The agreement also settled all future claims between Carma Easton and Creedmoor-Maha, including compensation and any claims related to Carma Easton's future acquisitions.

City of Austin's Notices of Intent to Provide Water Service to Areas Decertified from Creedmoor-Maha Water Supply Corporation in Travis County, Docket No. 47295, Order at 4 (Aug. 31, 2017).

I propose adding the following conclusions of law:

- The tract of land released by this Order is included in and subject to the agreement between Carma Easton and Creedmoor-Maha that the Commission approved in Docket No. 47295.
- The requirement under TWC § 13.254(d) to pay compensation for any property rendered useless or valueless to Creedmoor-Maha through decertification is satisfied by the agreement between Carma Easton and Creedmoor-Maha.

I propose also adding the following ordering paragraph:

• Any retail water utility may provide retail water service to the tract of land.

In addition, I propose delegating to Commission Advising and Docket Management staff the authority to modify the order to conform to the *Citation and Style Guide for the Public Utility Commission of Texas* and to make other non-substantive changes to the order for such matters as capitalization, spelling, grammar, punctuation, style, correction of numbering, and readability.

I look forward to discussing this matter with you at the open meeting.
