**ORDER NO. 7  
REQUIRING RESPONSE**


This Order addresses Commission Staff's July 17, 2018, motion to dismiss the application of Hood Water, LLC's (Hood Water) for administrative efficiency.

Commission Staff recommends dismissing the application without prejudice. Commission Staff indicates the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has twice denied the applicant approval for construction of the transmission line necessary for water delivery to the requested area. Under Title 16 of the Texas Administrative Code § 24.105(a)(14)(A), if the applicant receives a TCEQ disapproval letter, the application for a new water certificate of convenience and necessity may be subject to dismissal without prejudice.

On or before August 2, 2018, Hood Water shall file a response to Commission Staff's motion to dismiss. Alternatively, Hood Water may file a motion to withdraw the application. Failure to respond to this Order may result in dismissal of the application.
