COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Commission Staff's Notice Sufficiency Recommendation and would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On December 5, 2017, Hood Water LCC (Applicant) filed an application to obtain a water certificate of convenience and necessity in Parker County.

On January 5, 2018, the administrative law judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 2, finding application administratively complete, ordering Applicant to file proof of notice by February 20, 2018, and requiring Staff to file a recommendation on the sufficiency of Applicant's notice by March 2, 2018. Therefore, this pleading is timely field.

II. NOTICE SUFFICIENCY RECOMMENDATION

Staff has reviewed the proof of notice filed by the Applicant on February 21, 2018, and recommends that the Applicant's notice be found sufficient.

Deadline for Applicant to file signed consent forms with the Commission	May 8, 2018
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Staff to file a final recommendation on the Application	May 25, 2018
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	1 '
