Dear Madam/Sir:

In response to the questions/request for supplemental information for the tariff for the Countryside Acres, H.O.A., Inc. proposed water system, please see below and the attachments.

An area rate study has been done. See Attached. The proposed rates in the tariff are derived from rate comparisons with the City of Midland, Texas; the City of Stanton, Texas, and the City of Odessa, Texas.

The information from the rate comparisons we utilized to calculate an average of \$5.39 per 1,000-3000 gallon of water. The town of Garden City, Texas charges, \$15 for 2000 minimum. This rate is not used in the comparison, but, is noted as a neighboring market water availability factor.

Research backing up the proposed rates reveals daily family usage at 246 gallons per residence per the Texas Water Development Board on-line data. Assumptions: 246 gallons per meter per day; no extraordinary expenses in

serving the water system customers; electricity and other service costs do not increase more than typical inflation.

The water wells are still in the development stage. Tentatively construction will begin November 1, 2019, or when the water wells are complete, then the excavation for the water delivery lines can be started. At the same time the plant site can be completed and equipment moved in and assembled for testing.

An estimated date for completion of the physical plant is January 15, 2020. This would be the estimated date of service.




