**ORDER NO. 14
CLARIFYING ORDER NO. 13 AND GRANTING REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**


This Order addresses the request for an extension filed on August 21, 2019 by Commission Staff. Commission Staff indicated additional information required of Countryside has not yet been made available on the Commission interchange, and requests additional time to file a supplemental final recommendation and joint proposed order in order to allow for time to review documents and incorporate additional information.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) clarifies that Order No. 13 did not require Countryside Acres Homeowners Association, Inc. to file any additional information. Order No. 13 requested that Commission Staff make a determination on whether Countryside complied with and provided documentation of the requirements of 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 25.25 (b)(B)(i)-(vi), and provide analysis on whether the Commission should approve the rates in the tariff on an interim basis.

The ALJ approves the request for extension. On or before October 24, 2019, Commission Staff must file a supplemental final recommendation and a supplemental joint proposed final order.
