This Order addresses Commission Staff's March 12, 2018, recommendation that Countryside Acres Homeowners Association Inc.'s application is not administratively complete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's pleading and memorandum of Leila Guerrero of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division.


Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation the application is administratively incomplete. Applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made; thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.¹

On or before April 12, 2018, Countryside shall amend the application to cure the deficiencies described by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before May 11, 2018, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule if appropriate.
