

On March 18, 2019, a proposed order was issued in this docket, and on April 2, 2019, Forest Glen filed suggested corrections to the proposed order. The following changes are appropriate and have been made to the proposed order:

Findings of Fact

- 27. On May-21 18, 2018, the SOAH ALJ convened a prehearing conference and entered appearances by Forest Glen, Commission Staff, Fleming Mitchell, Van Johnson, Dennis Brown, and Cecil Perkins.
- 60. On August 9, 2018, Forest Glen Fleming Mitchell filed-the his direct testimony and exhibits-of Fleming Mitchell.
- 83. Forest Glen's application reflects a revenue requirement of \$267,262309,571.

Rate Design

91. The parties to the settlement agreed that the next rate change or tariff change application Forest Glen's files with the Commission will propose a rate design that includes both a fixed charge and a variable rate.

Conclusions of Law

3. Forest Glen is a class—B C utility as defined in TWC § 13.002(4-c) and 16 TAC § 24.3(17).
