COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON SUFFICIENCY

COMES NOW the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and files this Recommendation on Sufficiency. In support thereof, Staff shows the following.

I. Background

On December 21, 2018, Forest Glen Utility Company (Forest Glen or Applicant), Sewer Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 21070 in Medina County, filed an application (Application) with the Commission for authority to change its rates. Order No. 1 instructed Staff to file a recommendation on administrative completeness and notice by January 21, 2018.

II. Recommendation

As detailed in the attached memorandum of Gregory Charles and Fred Bednarski of the Water Utilities Division, Staff recommends that the Application is insufficient for filing and that notice should not be issued. The attached memorandum instructs the Applicant how it may improve the Application. A verification form is also attached. Staff further recommends that the Applicant be allowed until February 21, 2018 to cure the Application and that Staff be allowed until March 22, 2018 to make a supplemental recommendation.

III. Conclusion

Staff requests the issuance of an order consistent with the above recommendations.

On December 21, 2017, Forest Glen Utility Company (Forest Glen or Applicant), Sewer Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 21070, filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) for a sewer rate/tariff change in Medina County, Texas. An administrative review of this application is being made pursuant to Texas Water Code § 13.1871 (TWC) and 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.8 and 24.22 (TAC).

During the administrative review of the application, Staff found errors and deficiencies in the application which must be addressed prior to Forest Glen filing the notice with their customers. Therefore, Staff recommends the Commission deem the application deficient and insufficient for filing. In order to cure the errors and deficiencies, Staff recommends the Applicant provide the following:

- 1. Updated Schedules II to include 2014 year's expense amounts. If any of the test year amounts are higher than previous years, please indicate the reason for the increase.
- 2. Updated Schedule II-7 containing an explanation why the Materials amount is N/A on II-7 and not included on Schedule I-1.
- 3. Provide a legible copy (larger font size) of Schedule III-3.
- 4. Provide a legible copy of the rate design page, FGU Rate 051.
- 5. Updated Schedule IV (a) to include the total amounts at the bottom and update Schedule I-1 row 26 to include the tax amounts from Schedule II-IV (a).
- 6. Updated Schedule III-5 containing the correct O & M Expense amount, and recalculate the working cash amount based on Class C since Forest Glen has less than 500 connections. Update Schedule III-2 with the correct working cash amount, then update Schedule III-1 and recalculate the Return on Rate base amount. Update Schedule V and I-1 with the updated Return on Rate base amount and Income Tax amount.
- 7. Update Schedule I-1 with the new amount(s), and recalculate Schedule I-1 after updating all the supporting schedules.

- 8. File a copy of the attached affidavit attesting to the correctness of the application in accordance with the instructions for the Class B rate application, page 7, "Attachments required for sufficiency".
- 9. Copy of the Forest Glen's most recently approved tariff.

Staff additionally recommends suspension of the effective date of the rate increase pursuant to 16 TAC § 24.26 (a).
