**ORDER NO. 2**  
**FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE; ESTABLISHING**  
**OPPORTUNITY TO CURE AND SUSPENDING EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's January 19, 2018 recommendation on administrative completeness of Forest Glen Utility Company's application. Commission Staff recommended the application be found deficient for the reasons specified in the pleading and the memorandum of Gregory Charles and Fred Bednarski of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff recommended that Forest Glen Utility Company be provided an opportunity to cure the deficiencies and proposed deadlines for continued processing of the application. Commission Staff also recommended the proposed effective date of the rate increase be suspended in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.26(a).


Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application is deemed administratively incomplete and deficient. Additionally, the proposed effective date of the rate increase is suspended.

On or before February 21, 2018, Forest Glen Utility Company shall file the additional information to cure the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff.

On or before March 22, 2018, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation on sufficiency of the application and notice, and propose a procedural schedule, if appropriate. Staff shall also comment on whether the proposed effective date for the rate increase should remain suspended.
