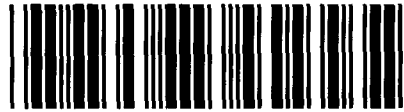

**Subject: Docket #47901, Application of Bracero Water Supply Corporation for exempt utility  
Registration**

On January 26, 2018 PUC staff found the subject docket number administratively incomplete due to an overlap with two entities: the Upper Guadalupe River Authority (UGRA) and the Gillespie County Water Control and Improvement District 1 (Gillespie County WCID 1). Staff therefore required written authorization from those entities be obtained and filed. Permission from UGRA is included in this filing as page 2.

On our request for authorization, UGRA responded immediately and positively.

We had difficulty reaching Gillespie County WCID 1, as they do not have a listed phone number. However, on February 2, 2018, we were able to communicate with Jennifer Ellebracht of the District and requested the same authorization from Gillespie County WCID 1 that we obtained from UGRA. Ms. Ellebracht said she would communicate our request to the District Board. We called Ms. Ellebracht again on February 7, 2018, and renewed our request. As of this date, we have not received a reply from Gillespie County WCID 1.

Upon receipt of a memo, dated January 26, 2018 addressed to Erika Garcia, the Upper Guadalupe River Authority ("Authority") was made aware that the Kamira Water System ("KWS") has applied for an exemption for Bracero, a new water supply corporation, requiring a CCN to serve an area that includes part of the Authority's geographic area in Kerr County (see attached map).

The Authority does not oppose KWS or Bracero providing water utility service in the area designed in the exemption application, specifically in the area that overlaps with or operates within the Authority's boundaries.
