

Docket No. 47912 – *Ratepayers' Appeal of the Decision by South Central Calhoun County Water Control and Improvement District No. 1 to Change Rates*

I recommend adopting the revised proposed order in this proceeding with the changes set forth below.

Proposed findings of fact 25 and 71 should be deleted as unnecessary to support the order. Subsequent findings should be renumbered.

25. — ~~On April 18, 2019, the Commission considered the agreement and a memorandum filed by Commissioner Botkin.~~

71. — ~~This docket does not contain any remaining contested issues of fact or law.~~

Proposed conclusion of law 11 should be modified, and a new conclusion of law should be created from the last sentence of proposed conclusion of law 11, for clarity and accuracy. Subsequent conclusions of law should be renumbered.

11. The rates approved in this Order are just and reasonable and are not unreasonably discriminatory, preferential, or prejudicial in compliance with TWC § 13.043(j).

XX. The rates approved in this Order are sufficient, equitable, and consistent in application to each class of customers in compliance with TWC § 13.043(j).

Finally, I propose delegating to the Office of Policy and Docket Management staff the authority to modify the order to conform to the *Citation and Style Guide for the Public Utility Commission of Texas* and to make other non-substantive changes to the order for such matters as capitalization, spelling, grammar, punctuation, style, correction of numbering, and readability.
