SUFFICIENT; AND ADOPTING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE


This Order addresses Commission Staff's February 1, 2018, recommendation on the administrative completeness of Primewood Investments, LP's petition and notice. Commission Staff recommended that the petition be found administratively complete and notice be found sufficient.
