## ORDER NO. 2 DEEMING PETITION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE AND FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT; ADOPTING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND GRANTING INTERVENTION

This Order addresses Commission Staff's February 1, 2018, recommendation on the administrative completeness of Primewood Investments, LP's petition and notice. Commission Staff recommended that the petition be deemed administratively complete and notice be found sufficient. Commission Staff proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing of the petition.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the petition is deemed administratively complete and the notice is sufficient. The following procedural schedule shall apply:
