**ORDER NO. 1
SETTTING DEADLINES**

On January 3, 2018, the Beeville Water Supply District filed a petition with the Commission in accordance with Texas Water Code §§ 12.013 and 13.043(f)¹ appealing the City of Corpus Christi's proposed wholesale raw water rates and requesting interim rates. Petitioner requests that the Commission find the rates adversely affect the public interest.

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.131(a), the Commission is required to determine, within 30 days of filing, whether the appeal contains all of the information required by the subchapter. For purposes of 16 TAC § 24.131 only, the rule states that the initial review of probable grounds shall be limited to determining whether the appeal meets the requirements of 16 TAC § 24.130. On or before February 2, 2018, Commission Staff shall file a recommendation on whether the appeal meets the requirements of 16 TAC § 24.130.

In accordance with 16 TAC § 22.104(2), the deadline to intervene in this proceeding is February 17, 2018.
