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COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Commission Staff's Request for an Extension and would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On January 3, 2018, Dal-High Water LLC and Monarch Utilities I, L.P. (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Henderson County. Specifically, Dal-High seeks approval to transfer all of its water service area under certificate of convenience and necessity No. 12830 to Monarch Utilities I, L.P. The total area being requested includes approximately 32 acres and services 46 current customers.

On August 24, 2018, the administrative law judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 6, requiring parties to jointly file a proposed notice of approval, including findings of fact, conclusions of law and ordering paragraphs by October 5, 2018. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION

Staff has not yet received Dal-High's Consent Form and requests a one week extension to enable Dal-High or Monarch on Dal-High's behalf to file the Consent Form with the Commission. Staff is authorized to represent that Monarch is unopposed to Staff's request.

III. CONCLUSION


Staff respectfully requests that the ALJ issue an order consistent with the above request.
