**ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT;
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's February 1, 2018 recommendation that the application of Dal-High Water LLC and Monarch Utilities I, L.P. for a sale, transfer or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Henderson County be deemed administratively incomplete and insufficient for filing due to material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's filing and the memorandum of Fred Bednarski in the Commission's Water Utilities Regulation Division. Commission Staff proposed deadlines for applicants to complete the application and for a supplemental recommendation on sufficiency.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application is found administratively incomplete and deficient. Applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made; thus, at this time this application is not considered filed with the Commission.¹

On or before March 5, 2018, applicants shall amend the application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed. On or before March 30, 2018, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness.
