COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS AND PROPOSED NOTICE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and in response to Order No. 1, files this Recommendation on Administrative Completeness and Proposed Notice. Staff recommends that the application be deemed sufficient for further review. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On January 5, 2018, Albury Manor Utility Company, Inc. (Albury Manor) filed an application to amend its water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 11507 and to decertify the Albury Trail Estates service area in Harris County. The total area being requested includes approximately one hundred (100) acres and zero (0) customers.

On January 10, 2018, Order No. 1 was issued establishing a deadline of February 5, 2018, for Staff to file a recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application, the sufficiency of the proposed notice, and to propose a procedural schedule. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

As detailed in the attached memorandum of Emily Sears of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, Staff has reviewed the application and recommends that it be found administratively complete and accepted for filing.

III. NOTICE

As detailed in the attached memorandum, Staff recommends that Albury Manor be directed to use the attached forms to provide notice of the application to the following:

- cities, districts, and neighboring retail public utilities providing the same utility service whose corporate boundaries or certificated service area are located within two miles from the outer boundary of the requested area;
- the county judge of each county that is wholly or partially included in the requested area;
- each groundwater conservation district that is wholly or partially included in the requested area; and
- affected customers; and
- publish notice once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in Harris County.

Albury Manor must provide an accurate map delineating the requested service area with each individual notice to neighboring utilities, other affected parties, and customers. Information related to districts including addresses can be obtained by the Applicant from the TCEQ web site located at <u>http://www14.tceq.texas.gov/iwud/</u>.

Albury Manor must also file in the docket an affidavit specifying every person and entity to whom notice was provided and the date that the notice was provided within 30 days of the date of the notice. In addition, file the publisher's affidavit for proof of newspaper publication. It is recommended that the Applicant use the attached notices and affidavits to meet these requirements.

IV. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff recommends the application be found administratively complete. Staff therefore proposes the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for Albury Manor to file with the Commission signed affidavits that the notice was given along with a copy of the notice sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	March 20, 2018
Deadline for Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	Within 10 days of Albury Manor filing proof of completed notice with the Commission
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued

V. CONCLUSION
