**FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE AND
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's February 6, 2018, recommendation that MSEC Enterprises, Inc.'s (MSEC) application is not administratively complete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in the memorandum of Debbie Tamayo of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff also noted that the notice should not be issued until the application is found administratively complete.


Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation the application is administratively incomplete. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made; thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before March 8, 2018, MSEC shall amend the application to cure the deficiencies described by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed. Notice shall not be issued until the application is administratively complete.

On or before April 5, 2018, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
