**ORDER NO. 3  
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE AND  
REQUIRING NOTICE; AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**


This Order addresses Commission Staff's April 5, 2018, supplemental recommendation on the administrative completeness of MSEC Enterprises, Inc.'s application to amend a water certificate of convenience and necessity in Montgomery County. Commission Staff recommended the application be found administratively complete and that MSEC be required to provide notice as recommended by Debbie Reyes Tamayo of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff also recommended that MSEC be required to file signed affidavits indicating that notice was given, along with a copy of the actual notices issued, within 30 days of the date of notice and the last publication date. Commission Staff proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing of the application.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application is deemed administratively complete. MSEC shall provide notice of the application consistent with Commission Staff's supplemental recommendation using the included forms. Commission Staff's proposed procedural schedule is adopted as follows:

Deadline for the applicant to file with the Commission signed affidavits that the notice was given along with a copy of the notice sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	May 18, 2018
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	Within 10 days of the applicant filing proof of completed notice with the Commission
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
