COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and in response to Order No. 1, files this Recommendation on Administrative Completeness. Staff recommends that the application be deemed sufficient for further review. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On February 9, 2018, Terra Investments, LP (Terra) filed a petition for an expedited release from Aqua Texas, Inc.'s (Aqua Texas) Sewer Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 21065, in Montgomery County. Specifically, Petitioner requested for expedited release is approximately 20.38 acres.

On January 19, 2018, Order No. 1 was issued, establishing a deadline of February 9, 2018, for Staff to file a recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application. This pleading is therefore timely filed.

II. ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

As detailed in the attached memorandum from Gregory Charles in the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, Staff has reviewed the application filed by Applicants, and recommends that it be found administratively complete.

III. NOTICE SUFFICIENCY

Terra asserts in its petition that it provided notice to the CCN holder, Aqua Texas, by certified mail on January 10, 2018. As previously noted, the Commission also published notice of this petition in the *Texas Register* on February 2, 2018. Such notice meets the requirement of 16

Tex. Admin. Code (TAC) § 24.113(s). Accordingly, Staff recommends that the notice issued be found sufficient.

Water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity by Expedited Release in

Montgomery County

On January 10, 2018, Terra Investments, LP (Petitioner) filed a petition with the Commission for expedited release from Aqua Texas, Inc.'s water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 21065 in Montgomery County, under Texas Water Code Chapter § 13.254(a-5) (TWC) and 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.113(l) (TAC). The Petitioner asserts that the land is at least 25 acres, is not receiving water service, and is located in Montgomery County which is a qualifying county.

The Petitioner submitted adequate maps delineating the requested area for expedited release with enough detail to confirm the accurate positioning of their digital data pursuant to 16 TAC § 24.119. The map and digital data are sufficient for determining the location of the requested release areas within Aqua Texas, Inc.'s certificated area. Mapping Staff was able to confirm the acreage of the subject properties, and determined that the requested areas are located within the subject property. Furthermore, the Petitioner provided a warranty deed confirming the Petitioners' ownership of the tracts of land within the subject property.

The Petitioner submitted a sworn affidavit attesting that the petition is being filed in accordance with 16 TAC § 24.113(l)(3)(A), as well as proof that a copy of the Petition was sent via certified mail to Aqua Texas, Inc.

The petition meets the criteria set forth in TWC § 13.254 (a-5) and 16 TAC §24.113(l). Therefore, Staff recommends that the petition be deemed administratively complete and sufficient for filing.
