#### NOTICE OF APPROVAL

This Notice addresses the petition of Terra Investments, LP (Terra) for the expedited release of approximately 20.38 acres of land within Aqua Texas, Inc.'s sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 21065 in Montgomery County. Commission Staff recommended approval of the petition. The petition is approved.

The Commission adopts the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

### I. Findings of Fact

#### Procedural History, Description and Background

- On January 10, 2018, Terra filed a petition for the expedited release of portion of a 384.2acre tract of land it owns in Montgomery County from Aqua Texas' sewer CCN No. 21065.
  Terra requests the removal of approximately 20.38 acres located within Aqua Texas' sewer CCN No. 21065.
- 2. On January 19, 2018, Order No. 1 was issued requiring comments on the administrative completeness of the petition and notice, and establishing procedural schedule.
- 3. On February 9, 2018, Commission Staff recommended that the petition and notice be deemed administratively complete.
- 4. On February 16, 2018, Order No. 2 was issued finding the petition administratively complete, notice sufficient, and establishing a procedural schedule.
- 5. On March 2, 2018, Commission Staff recommended (a) approval of the petition, (b) that no property would be rendered useless or valueless by decertification, and (c) that no

- compensation proceeding is necessary. Commission Staff also provided an amended certificate and service area map.
- 6. The map and certificate referenced in Findings of Fact No. 5 are attached to this Notice.
- 7. No motions to intervene or request for hearing were filed in this proceeding.

#### Notice

8. Notice of the petition was published in the *Texas Register* on February 2, 2018.

#### **Project Description**

- 9. Terra owns the 20.38 acres of land in Montgomery County.
- 10. The 20.38 acres are part of the 384.2-acre tract of land owned by Terra.
- 11. The 20.38 acres are located within Aqua Texas' sewer CCN No. 21065 service area.
- 12. The 384.2-acre tract of land is located in a qualifying.

#### Sewer Service

- 13. The 384.2-acre tract of land, including the 20.38 acres Terra seeks to have decertified from sewer CCN No. 21065, is not receiving sewer service from Aqua Texas as that term has been defined by the Courts.
- 14. The 384.2-acre tract of land, including the 20.38 acres Terra seeks to have decertified from sewer CCN No. 21065, is not receiving actual sewer service from Aqua Texas.

#### Useless or Valueless

15. Aqua Texas has no property that is rendered useless or valueless by the decertification.

#### II. Conclusions of Law

1. The Commission has jurisdiction over this petition under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.254(a-5).1

- 2. Notice of the petition was provided in compliance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.113(l)(3)(A)(vi) and 16 TAC §§ 22.54-.55.
- 3. Montgomery County is a qualifying county under TWC § 13.254(a-5) and 16 TAC § 24.113(l)(2)(D).
- 4. The 384.2-acre tract of land is not receiving sewer service from Aqua Texas under TWC § 13.254(a-5).
- 5. The 20.38 acres to be decertified under TWC § 13.254(a-5) are part of an area of land owned by Terra that is at least 25 acres.
- 6. Aqua Texas did not intervene in this proceeding, therefore under 16 TAC § 24.113(n)(3), Aqua Texas had no property rendered useless or valueless property as a result of the requested decertification.
- 7. No property of Aqua Texas has been rendered useless or valueless by the decertification, therefore, under TWC § 13.254(d)-(g) no compensation is owed to Aqua Texas.
- 8. Because no compensation is owed under TWC § 13.254(d)-(g), a retail public utility may render retail sewer service directly or indirectly to the public in the decertified area without providing compensation to Aqua Texas.
- 9. Terra is entitled to approval of the petition, having sufficiently satisfied the requirements of TWC § 13.254(a-5) and 16 TAC § 24.113(l) by adequately demonstrating ownership of a tract of land that is at least 25 acres, is located in a qualifying county, and is not receiving sewer service from Aqua Texas.
- 10. Under TWC § 13.257(r), Aqua Texas is required to record a certified copy of the approved certificate and map, along with a boundary description of the service area, in the real property records of each county in which the service area or a portion of the service area is located, and submit to the Commission evidence of the recording.

## III. Ordering Paragraphs

In accordance with these findings of fact and conclusions of law, the Commission issues the following orders:

- 1. The petition is approved.
- 2. Terra's 20.38 acres are released from Agua Texas' sewer CCN No. 21065.
- 3. Aqua Texas' sewer CCN No. 21065 is amended in accordance with this Notice.
- 4. The Commission's official service area boundary maps for Aqua Texas shall reflect this change as shown in the attached maps.
- 5. Aqua Texas shall comply with the recording requirements of TWC § 13.257(r) and (s) for the area in Montgomery County affected by the petition and submit to the Commission evidence of the recording no later than 31 days after receipt of this Notice.
- 6. All other motions and any other requests for general or specific relief, if not expressly granted, are denied.


