

The Decker Hills Water system in Montgomery County is located approximately 8 miles southeast of Magnolia, Texas.

It is generally bounded on the north by Huffsmith Dobbin Road, Marvin Gardens Street, and Turriff Circle; on the east by Dry Creek and Long Lake, Elm Lane, and Hardin Store Road; on the west by Collier Smith Road, Dobbin Huffsmith Road, and Mill Creek, and on the south by Shady Lane and Hardin Store Road.
