The proposed rates will apply to service received after the effective date provided below, unless modified or suspended by the Commission. The Utility may install a master meter for a multi-unit building and bill the customer the equivalent units for such building at the 5'8" monthly minimum charge set forth above plus the gallonage charge. The gallonage for each tier will be determined by multiplying the gallonage by the number of units. For example, a 20 unit customer's first tier gallonage will be 60,000 or 20 times 3,000.
