

On May 4, 2018, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) received planning material for the proposed water system improvements. Based on our review, the project generally meets the minimum requirements of Title 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Chapter 290 – Rules and Regulations for Public Water Systems and is conditionally approved for construction if the project meets the following requirement(s):

- Executed contract between the Red River Authority and the City of Vernon to deliver treated water at a rate of 0.6 gallons per minute (gpm) per active connection.
- Approval of the certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) sale, transfer, merger (STM) application from the Public Utility Commission.
- Ground storage tanks shall be air-gapped in accordance with Chapter 290.38(1).
- Waterline locations shall comply with Chapter 290.44(e) with regard to separation distances from sources of potential contamination.
- Stream crossings shall comply with Chapter 290.44(f) with regard to valving.

The submittal consisted of 42 sheets of engineering drawings, technical specifications and an engineering summary. The proposed project, to deliver treated water from the City of Vernon, consists of:

- 20,800 linear feet (lf) of 8-inch ASTM D2241 SDR21 PVC pipe;
- Various lengths of 6-inch and 8-inch AWWA C-906, PE4710, DR13.5, or thicker, HDPE pipe;
- Hines Wildcat Pump Station (11734 CR 103)
  - o One 60,000 gallon AWWA D100 welded steel ground storage tank;
  - o Two 15 horsepower (hp) high service pumps rated at 175 gpm each at 190 feet total dynamic head (tdh);
  - o One 3,000 gallon ASME welded steel pressure tank;
  - Gaseous chlorine disinfection;
  - o Demolition of existing facilities;

- o Two 15 hp transmission pumps rated at 175 gpm each at 190 feet tdh;
- 30,700 lf of 6-inch ASTM D2241 SDR21 PVC pipe;
- Northside WSC Pump Station (11502 FM 924W)
  - o One 35,000 gallon AWWA D100 welded steel ground storage tank;
  - o Two 15 hp high service pumps rated at 175 gpm each at 190 feet tdh;
  - o One 3,000 gallon ASME welded steel pressure tank;
  - o Gaseous chlorine disinfection;
  - o Demolition of existing facilities.

This approval is for the construction of the above listed items only. Any wastewater components contained in this design were not considered.

An appointed engineer must notify the TCEQ's Region 3 Office in Abilene at (325) 698-9674 when construction will start. Please keep in mind that upon completion of the water works project, the engineer or owner will notify the commission's Water Supply Division, in writing, as to its completion and attest to the fact that the completed work is substantially in accordance with the plans and change orders on file with the commission as required in 30 TAC §290.39(h)(3).
