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APPLICATION OF NORTHSIDE WATER SUPPLY CORPORATION AND RED RIVER AUTHORITY OF TEXAS FOR SALE, TRANSFER, OR MERGER OF FACILITIES AND CERTIFICATE RIGHTS IN WILBARGER COUNTY PUBLIC UTHER FEESMINISSION OF TEXAS

COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS AND PROPOSED NOTICE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and in response to Order No. 1, files this Recommendation on Administrative Completeness and Proposed Notice. Staff recommends that the application be deemed sufficient for further review. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On January 31, 2018, Northside Water Supply Corporation (Northside WSC) and Red River Authority of Texas (Red River) (collectively, Applicants), filed an application for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Wilbarger County. Specifically, Northside WSC seeks approval to transfer all of its water service area under certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 10631 to Red River.

On February 2, 2018, Order No. 1 was issued, establishing a deadline of March 2, 2018, for Staff to file a recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application and notice and propose a procedural schedule for further processing of the application. This pleading is therefore timely filed.

II. ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

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As detailed in the attached memorandum from Kathryn Eiland in the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, Staff has reviewed the application filed by Applicants, and recommends that it be found administratively complete.

III. NOTICE

As detailed in the attached memorandum, Staff recommends that Applicants be directed to use the attached forms to provide notice to the following:

- cities, districts, and neighboring retail public utilities providing the same utility service whose corporate boundaries or certificated service area are located within two miles from the outer boundary of the requested area; and
- the county judge of each county that is wholly or partially included in the requested area;
- each groundwater conservation district that is wholly or partially included in the requested area; and
- affected customers

Provide correct notice of the application to the following:

• Wilbarger County Judge

Applicants must provide an accurate map delineating the requested service area with each individual notice to neighboring utilities, other affected parties, and customers. Information related to districts including addresses can be obtained by the Applicant from the TCEQ web site located at <u>http://www14.tceq.texas.gov/iwud/</u>.

Applicants must also file in the docket, an affidavit specifying every person and entity to whom notice was provided and the date that the notice was provided within 30 days of the date of the notice. It is recommended that the Applicant use the attached notice and affidavit to meet these requirements.

IV. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff proposes the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for Applicants to file with the Commission signed affidavits that the notice was given along with a copy of the notice sent to the affected parties	April 2, 2018
Deadline for Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	Within 10 day of Applicant filing proof of completed notice with the Commission
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued

V. CONCLUSION

For the reasons detailed above, Staff recommends that the application be found administratively complete, that Applicants be directed to provide notice as detailed above and in the attached memorandum, and that the procedural schedule proposed above be adopted.
