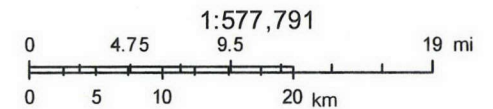

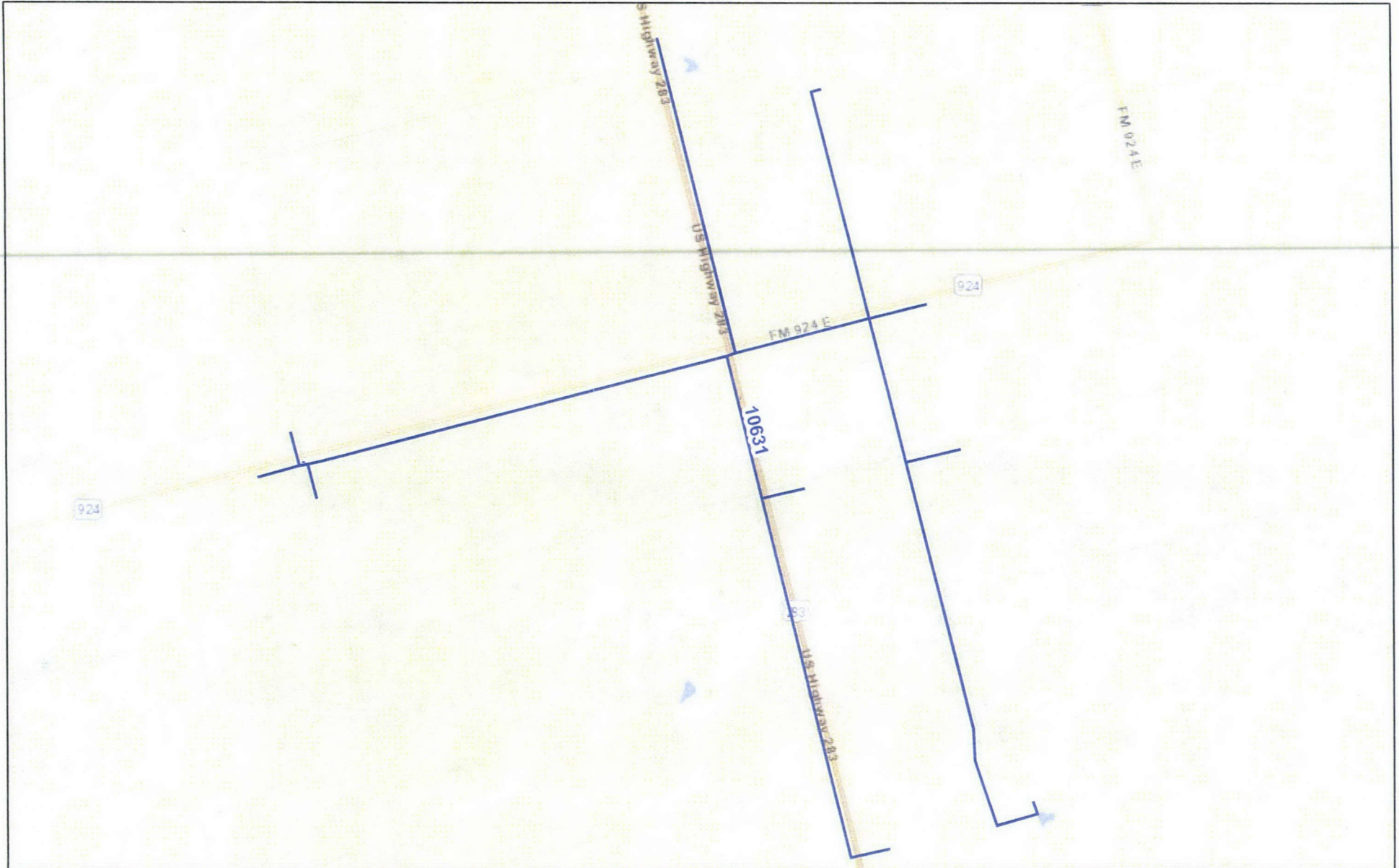

— Water CCN Facility Lines



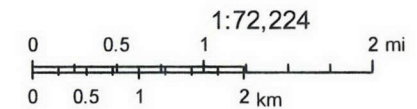
