**COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST TO AMEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Request to Amend Procedural Schedule and would show the following:

**I. BACKGROUND**

On February 7, 2018, Crystal Springs Water Company, Inc. (Crystal Springs) filed a petition to amend its water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 11373 in Montgomery County. Specifically, Crystal Springs requests a total service area of approximately 102 acres with zero current customers. Order No. 5, issued May 22, 2018, found Crystal Springs' notice sufficient and set forth a procedural schedule. Pursuant to the procedural schedule, the deadline for Staff to provide a final map and certificate to Crystal Springs is June, 20, 2018.

**II. REQUEST TO AMEND**

Staff respectfully requests that the Administrative Law Judge modify the procedural schedule to give Staff additional time to process the application. Crystal Springs' response to Staff's second set of requests for information is not due until June 25, 2018, and Staff needs time to review the responses. Staff has contacted a representative of Crystal Springs who stated that Crystal Springs is not opposed to this request.

**III. AMENDED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

Staff proposes the following amended procedural schedule:

Notice completed	March 21, 2018
Deadline for intervention	April 20, 2018
Deadline for Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable), to Crystal Springs for review and consent	August 2, 2018
Deadline for Crystal Springs to file signed consent forms with the Commission	August 13, 2018
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	August 20, 2018
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Crystal Springs to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	August 28, 2018

#### **IV. CONCLUSION**

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an Order adopting the amended procedural schedule proposed above.


