**ORDER NO. 5
FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND
ADOPTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's June 22, 2018, supplemental recommendation regarding Quadvest, L.P.'s sufficiency of notice and proposed procedural schedule.


In Order No. 4 issued June 12, 2018, the administrative law judge (ALJ) found the notice deficient and provided Quadvest an opportunity to cure the deficiencies by June 29, 2018. In addition, the ALJ granted Quadvest a good cause exception under Title 16 of the Texas Administrative Code §22.5. The exception allowed Quadvest to publish notice on two nonconsecutive weeks based on its partial completion of the notice requirement. Commission Staff was required to file a supplemental recommendation on the sufficiency of the notice along with a proposed procedural schedule by July 9, 2018. Commission Staff recommended the ALJ deem the notice sufficient.

The ALJ finds the notice sufficient. Commission Staff's supplemental procedural schedule shall apply:
