**ORDER NO. 10
GRANTING AMENDED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Quadvest, L.P.'s (Quadvest) application to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 11612 and sewer CCN number 20952 in Fort Bend.


In Order No. 9 issued December 13, 2018, the administrative law judge (ALJ) granted Commission Staff's fourth request to amend the procedural schedule and established a deadline for Commission Staff's to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs to the applicant for review and consent by February 19, 2019. Quadvest has two pending applications (Docket No. 47072 and 47440) to amend its water and sewer certificates of convenience and necessity in Montgomery County. The two pending dockets are being reconciled. Until the tariffs in Quadvest's pending dockets are reconciled, Commission Staff has no current base tariff it can rely upon to implement the revision requested in this application. Therefore, Commission Staff is unable to fulfill the requirement in Order No. 9 mandating a revised tariff for approval.

The ALJ grants Commission Staff's request to amend the procedural schedule and the following procedural schedule applies:

Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable), to the applicant for review and consent	April 16, 2019
Deadline for the applicant to file signed consent forms with the Commission	April 30, 2019
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	May 7, 2019
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file joint proposed findings of fact, including findings that address the factors in Texas Water Code § 13.246(c), and conclusions of law	May 14, 2019
