**COMMISSION STAFF'S MOTION TO AMEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

**COMES NOW** the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and files this Motion to Amend Procedural Schedule, and would show the following:

**I. BACKGROUND**

On February 7, 2018, Quadvest L.P. (Quadvest or Applicant) filed an application to amend its water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 11612 and sewer CCN No. 20952 in Fort Bend County. The total area being requested includes approximately one hundred eight (108) acres and zero (0) current customers.

Previously, on April 18, 2017, in Docket No. 47072, Quadvest filed an application to amend its water CCN No. 11612 and sewer CCN No. 20952 in Montgomery County. Subsequent to the filing of the application in Docket No. 47072, on May 17, 2018, the Commission's Office of Policy and Docket Management (OPD) approved a pass-thru rate change filed by Quadvest in Docket No. 48041 related to the same tariff at issue in Docket No. 47072. Thereafter, on June 14, 2018, OPD approved further pass-thru rate changes as filed by Quadvest in Docket Nos. 48051 and 48052. As a result, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) granted a motion to abate Docket No. 47072, so the tariff being considered in that proceeding could properly incorporate the changes approved in Docket Nos. 48041, 48051, and 48052. The docket was unabated on July 17, 2018. Thereafter, on November 21, 2018, the ALJ issued a notice of approval, including a revised tariff. On December 12, 2018, a corrected version of the sewer tariff was issued by the ALJ.

Additionally, on July 25, 2017, in Docket No. 47440, Quadvest filed an application to amend its water CCN No. 11612 and sewer CCN No. 20952 in Montgomery County. The ALJ granted nine motions for extension in Docket No. 47440 based on the parties' inability to submit a joint proposed notice of approval until the tariff in the aforementioned Docket No. 47072 had been reconciled. Following resolution of Docket No. 47072, on February 1, 2019, the parties filed

their joint proposed notice of approval and motion to admit evidence. On April 24, 2019, the ALJ issued a notice of approval, including a revised tariff.

Further, on December 27, 2017, in Docket No. 47910, Quadvest filed an application to amend its water CCN No. 11612 and sewer CCN No. 20952 and decertify a portion of another CCN holder's water service area in Harris County. The ALJ granted four motions for extension in Docket No. 47910 based on the parties' inability to file signed consent forms until a minor tariff change in another Quadvest matter, Docket No. 48323, was reconciled. On April 4, 2019, the tariff in Docket No. 48323 was approved. Nonetheless, there were two further extensions in Docket No. 47910, as Quadvest awaited receipt of approval documentation from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) necessary for Staff to provide its final recommendation in that matter. On May 31, 2019, Quadvest filed the approval documentation from the TCEQ. Thereafter, on August 2, 2019, Staff filed its Supplemental Final Recommendation. Most recently, on August 23, 2019, Quadvest filed a request to extend the deadline to provide the parties joint proposed notice of approval in order for the decertified CCN holder to file its required consent form.

On June 27, 2018, Order No. 5 was issued in this docket, No. 48034, establishing a deadline for Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs to the Applicant for review and consent by August 8, 2018.

On June 14, 2019, Order No. 12 was issued in this docket, No. 48034, granting Commission Staff's seventh request to amend the procedural schedule since there was no current base tariff upon which Staff could rely to implement the revisions requested in Applicant's application. Order No. 12 reset the deadline for Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs to the Applicant for review and consent to September 3, 2019. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

## **II. AMENDED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

The parties in the present docket await the resolution of only one additional Quadvest currently pending matter, Docket No. 47910. Until the tariff in Docket No. 47910 is reconciled, Staff has no current base tariff that can be used to implement the revisions requested in the subject application. Therefore, Staff requests an eight-week extension to its deadline to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs, in order to allow for the potential approval of the tariff in Quadvest's preceding CCN amendment docket. The remaining deadlines are also advanced accordingly. Staff's request would result in the following modifications to the procedural schedule:

Deadline for Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to Applicant for review and consent	October 29, 2019
Deadline for Applicant to file signed consent forms with the Commission	November 12, 2019
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	November 19, 2019
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	November 26, 2019

Staff has contacted Quadvest regarding the amended procedural schedule, and Quadvest agrees with the proposed dates.
