ORDER NO. 14 GRANTING AMENDED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses Quadvest, L.P.'s application to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 11612 and sewer CCN number 20952 in Fort Bend.

In Order No. 13 issued September 5, 2019, the administrative law judge (ALJ) granted Commission Staff's eighth request to amend the procedural schedule and established a deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs to the applicant for review and consent by October 29, 2019. Commission Staff requested an extension of time because the parties in the present docket were awaiting the approval of Quadvest's application in Docket No. 47910. Until the tariff in Docket No. 47910 is resolved, Commission Staff has no current base tariff that could be used to implement the revision requested in the application. On October 1, 2019, the Notice of Approval was issued and a clean copy of the tariff was filed on October 23, 2019.

However, Commission Staff has determined that other Quadvest water and sewer applications must be reconciled, including five pass-through rate changes applications, Docket Nos. 49124, 49213, 49214, 49215, 49216 and water and sewer CCN amendment application, Docket No. 48303. Until the tariffs in the aforementioned dockets are reconciled, Commission Staff has no current base tariff that can be used to implement the revisions requested in the subject application.

The ALJ grants Commission Staff's request and amends the procedural schedule and the following procedural schedule applies:

Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable), to the applicant for review and consent	January 21, 2020
Deadline for the applicant to file signed consent forms with the Commission	February 4, 2020



If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	February 11, 2020
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file joint proposed findings of fact, including findings that address the factors in Texas Water Code § 13.246(c), and conclusions of law	February 18, 2020
