ORDER NO. 1 REQUIRING COMMENTS ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS AND NOTICE; AND ADDRESSING PROCEDURAL MATTERS

I. Application

This Order addresses the February 8, 2018 application of Waterco of Nocona Lake Estates for exempt utility registration in accordance with Texas Water Code § 13.242(c) and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.103(e).

II. Requiring Comments on Administrative Completeness of Application and Procedural Schedule

On or before March 9, 2018, Commission Staff shall file comments regarding the administrative completeness of the application, how the application should be processed, and propose a procedural schedule, if necessary. Notice of this application will appear in the *Texas Register*.

III. Filings

Unless otherwise specified, an original and 10 copies of documents relating to this proceeding must be filed with the Commission filing clerk according to 16 TAC § 22.71. A copy of each document filed with the Commission must also be served on all parties as provided in 16 TAC § 22.74. All filings can be accessed on the PUC Interchange, http://interchange.puc.texas.gov.

All parties shall provide their current addresses, telephone and facsimile numbers, if available, to all other parties and the Commission by filing and serving all parties with such information. Each party shall provide the Commission and all parties with updated address, telephone, and facsimile information if such information changes. The telephone and facsimile



numbers will be placed on the service list for this proceeding. Parties are responsible for updating their own service lists to reflect changed information and the addition of any other parties.

IV. Ex Parte Communications

In accordance with 16 TAC § 22.3(b)(2), ex parte communications with the administrative law judge are prohibited. Parties should communicate with the administrative law judge only through written documents filed with the Commission's filing clerk and served on all parties.
