Application of Canyon Falls Municipal Utility District No. 1 of Denton County for a Water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity in Denton County

Pursuant to Texas Water Code § 13.257, Canyon Falls Municipal Utility District No. 1 of Denton County ("Canyon Falls"), holder of Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 13720, hereby files this Boundary Description for the water service area created by the PUC in a January 24, 2019, written order in Docket No. 48054. Canyon Falls' certificated service area is approximately 161 acres located approximately 3 miles south of the downtown Argyle and is bounded on the north by Forest Trail, on the east by Stonecrest Road, on the south by Canyon Falls Drive, and on the west by Graham Branch Creek and fully described in the District Information Form for Canyon Falls, as recorded in Document No. 2013-144754 of the Deed Records of Denton County. Canyon Falls' CCN is further depicted in the attached PUC map.

The Boundary Description is being filed on behalf of and at the request and instruction of Canyon Falls, based upon information and belief. Canyon Falls specifically authorizes the filing of this Boundary Description to comply with Texas Water Code §13.257 and its associated rules and regulation.
