**ORDER NO. 2  
FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT;  
AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's March 13, 2018 recommendation regarding administrative completeness of Canyon Falls Municipal Utility District No. 1's application. Commission Staff recommended that the application be deemed administratively incomplete as detailed in the memorandum of Jolie Mathis of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff recommended that Canyon Falls be provided an opportunity to cure the deficiencies.


Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation the application is incomplete and deficient. Applications are not considered filed with the Commission until a determination of administrative completeness is made; thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before April 13, 2018, applicants shall amend the application to cure the deficiencies described by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before May 14, 2018, Commission Staff shall submit a supplemental recommendation on the amended application, proposed notice, and propose a procedural schedule if the application is found to be administratively complete.
