This Order addresses DJL Ventures, Inc. d/b/a KAP Water Supply and SWWC Utilities, Inc. d/b/a Water Services, Inc.'s (collectively, applicants) application for the transfer of service area rights in Comal County. On November 15, 2018, Commission Staff recommended that the administrative law judge (ALJ) find the closing documents sufficient under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.239(n).

The ALJ finds the closing documentation sufficient. However, the transfer of certificate rights requested in this application is not complete until the application receives final approval.

Deadline for parties to jointly file detailed, legally sufficient findings of fact and conclusions of law that meet the components of TWC § 13.246 and that supports the relief requested	January 10, 2019
