COMMISSION STAFF'S UNOPPOSED REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Unopposed Request for Extension of Time and would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On February 20, 2018, Park Water Company (Park) filed an application for a new water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Midland County. Park received requests for service for three proposed residential developments—The Meadows, Chaney Ranch, and King Ranch. Park plans to build two public water systems to serve these new developments, and the service area requested includes zero current customers. On February 22, 2018, the Administrative Law Judge issued Order No. 1 requiring Staff to file comments on the administrative completeness of the application and notice and to propose a procedural schedule by March 20, 2018. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Because this is an application for a new CCN that will require the construction of two new public water systems, Staff needs additional time to complete its review of the financial information submitted by Park. Staff has contacted counsel for Park who stated that the company is not opposed to the requested extension. Accordingly, Staff requests that its deadline to file comments be extended to March 27, 2018.



III. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order granting its request and extending its deadline to file comments on the administrative completeness of the application.
