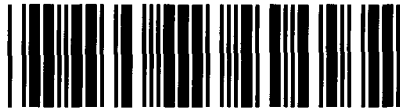

**ORDER NO. 3  
FINDING THE APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT;  
AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's March 27, 2018, recommendation that Park Water Company's application is not administratively complete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in the memorandum of Patricia Garcia of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application is incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made; thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before April 24, 2018, Park shall supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed. Notice shall not be issued until the application is administratively complete.

On or before May 22, 2018, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
