### **COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS**

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and in response to Order No. 1, files this Recommendation on Administrative Completeness. Staff recommends that the application be deemed sufficient for further review. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

#### I. BACKGROUND

On February 27, 2018, H20 Systems Plus/Coleto Water System (H20) and JRM Water, LLC dba JRM (JRM) (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Victoria County, Texas. Specifically, JRM seeks approval to acquire facilities and to transfer all water service area from H20 Systems Plus under water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 11548. The requested area includes approximately 437 acres and 211 connections.

On March 1, 2018, Order No. 1 was issued, establishing a deadline of March 27, 2018, for Staff to file a recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application and notice and propose a procedural schedule for further processing of the application.

#### H. ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

As detailed in the attached memorandum from Brannon Pennick in the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, Staff has reviewed the application and recommends that the application be found administratively complete.

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### III. NOTICE

As detailed in the attached memorandum, Staff further recommends the Applicants be ordered to do the following:

- 1) Provide notice of the application to:
  - a) cities and neighboring retail public utilities providing the same utility service whose corporate limits or certificated service area boundaries are within two miles from the outer boundary of the requested area, and any city with an extraterritorial jurisdiction that overlaps the requested area;
  - b) the county judge of each county that is wholly or partially included in the requested area;
  - c) each groundwater conservation district that is wholly or partially included in the requested area; and
  - d) affected customers.
- 2) Provide notice of the application to the following:
  - a) Goliad County WSC (CCN No. 13028);
  - b) Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority;
  - c) San Antonio River Authority;
  - d) Victoria County Groundwater Conservation District;
  - e) Victoria County Navigation District; and
  - f) Victoria County Judge.
- 3) File an affidavit in the docket specifying every person and entity to whom notice was provided, the date that the notice was provided, and one copy of the notice as it was provided. It is recommended that the Applicant use the attached notice and affidavit to meet these requirements.

### IV. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff recommends the application be found administratively complete. Staff therefore proposes the following procedural schedule:

# V. CONCLUSION

For the reasons detailed above, Staff recommends that the application be found administratively complete, that Applicants be directed to provide notice as detailed above and in the attached memorandum, and that the procedural schedule proposed above be adopted.

On February 27, 2018, JRM Water, LLC dba JRM (Purchaser or JRM) and H20 Systems Plus/Coleto Water System (Seller or H2O Systems Plus), collectively (Applicants) filed an application for Sale, Transfer, or Merger (STM) of facilities and certificate rights in Victoria County, Texas, pursuant to Texas Water Code Ann. (TWC) § 13.301 and the 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.109. An evidentiary hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.
