

UNDINE TEXAS ENVIRONMENTAL, LLC'S RESPONSE TO ORDER NO. 3

TO THE HONORABLE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE:

Undine Texas Environmental, LLC ("Undine") files this Response to Order No. 3. In support thereof, Undine states the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On March 8, 2019, Bolivar Utility Services, LLC ("Bolivar") and Undine (collectively "Applicants") filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas ("Commission") an application for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") rights in Galveston County, Texas (the "Application").

On June 4, 2018, the ALJ issued Order No. 3 finding that the Application was sufficient, requiring notice, and establishing a procedural schedule. On June 21, the ALJ issued Order No. 4 granting an extension until July 30, 2018 for Undine to file an affidavit attesting to Notice, and on July 30, 2018, the ALJ issued Order No. 5 granting an extension until September 28, 2018 for Undine to file a signed affidavit attesting to notice. Accordingly, this Response is timely filed.

has submitted an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to purchase facilities and to transfer sewer certificated service area under CCN No. 21026, in Galveston County, TX from:

Bolivar Utility Services, LLC P.O. Box 22858 Beaumont, TX 77720 (Seller's Name) (Address) (City), (State) (Zip Code)

The sale is scheduled to take place as approved by the Commission (V.T.C.A., Water Code § 13.301). The transaction and the transfer of the CCN includes the following subdivisions: <u>Laguna Harbor and Crystal Palace</u>.

The requested area subject to this transaction is located approximately 7 miles <u>north</u> of downtown <u>Galveston</u>, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by <u>East Bay and the Gulf Intercostal Waterway</u>; on the east by <u>a line approx</u>. 1.7 miles east of SH 124; on the south by <u>Gulf of Mexico</u> and on the west by <u>Galveston Bay</u>. The total requested area for the water or sewer CCN(s) being transferred includes approximately <u>37,468</u> acres and <u>702</u> current customers.

This transaction will have the following effect on the current customers' rates and services: This transaction will not affect the current customer's rates and services.

Persons who wish to intervene in the proceeding or comment upon action sought should contact the Public Utility Commission, P.O. Box 13326, Austin, Texas 78711-3326, or call the Public Utility Commission at (512) 936-7120 or (888) 782-8477. Hearing- and speech-impaired individuals with text telephones (TTY) may contact the commission at (512) 936-7136. The deadline for intervention in the proceeding is 30 days from the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later, unless otherwise provided by the presiding officer. You must send a letter requesting intervention to the commission which is received by that date.

If a valid public hearing is requested, the Commission will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. An evidentiary hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.
