**ORDER NO. 12
FINDING CLOSING DOCUMENTATION SUFFICIENT
AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Bolivar Utility Services, LLC and Undine Texas Environmental, LLC’s (collectively, applicants) application for the transfer of facilities and certificate service area rights in Galveston County. On October 10, 2019, Commission Staff recommended that the administrative law judge (ALJ) find the closing documentation sufficient under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.239(k) through (n) and the customer deposits properly addressed.

The ALJ finds the closing documentation sufficient and the customer deposits properly addressed. However, the transfer of certificate rights requested in this application is not complete until the application receives final approval.

The following procedural schedule applies for continued processing:
