### **NOTICE FINDING THE APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT; AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Notice addresses Commission Staff's recommendation regarding the sufficiency of Nerro Supply Investors, LLC's application for pass-through rate change. Commission Staff recommended that the application be deemed administratively incomplete and deficient. Staff recommended that Nerro be given until May 14, 2018 to cure the deficiencies as provided by Kathryn Eiland of the Water Utility Regulation Division on April 13, 2018. The Commission finds that Nerro's application is deficient and incomplete.

No later than May 14, 2018, Nerro shall provide new notice to customers and file supplemental documentation to cure the deficiencies in the application. Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation on the sufficiency of the application and notice no later than June 14, 2018.
