Dear Corporation Member

On March 12, 2018, the East Rio Hondo Water Supply Corporation (ERHWSC) Board of Directors approved the following water rate structure. The new rates and a change to the base usage, as outlined below, will take effect after April 30, 2018 and will apply to all billings mailed on or after May 30, 2018. Please note that this is a conservation rate structure. Members that use larger amounts of water will pay more per thousand gallons as they use more of the system's capacity.

In addition to the minimum monthly rate noted in the table above, a gallonage charge shall be added at the following rates for usage above the base usage during any one (1) billing period. The gallonage charge is <u>unchanged</u> from previous rates

- 1) \$3.00 per 1,000 gallons for any gallonage between 1 and 8,000 gallons above base usage;
- 2) \$3.50 per 1,000 gallons for any gallonage between 8,001 and 18,000 gallons above base usage;
- 3) \$3.75 per 1,000 gallons for any gallonage between 18,001 and 48,000 gallons above base usage;
- 4) \$4.25 per 1,000 gallons for any gallonage 48,001 gallons or more above base usage.

The following change to the Corporation fee schedule is as follows:

After serious consideration the Board of Directors implemented this rate change to meet financial requirements for continued operational expenses and the ERHWSC capital improvement program. ERHWSC budgets continue to be largely influenced by principle, interest, depreciation, and debt reserve requirements associated with loans for critical water plant and pipeline projects. As an example, one of these projects, the Bean Rd. Water Transmission Line, will eliminate a significant hydraulic bottle neck in the middle of the distribution system and will allow water to flow east to west and vice-versa. This bi-directional flow allows alternative and emergency sources of water to reach both east and west ends of the distribution system from the opposite end. The project will require \$1,373,700 in funding for ERHWSC. Through the United States Department of Agriculture, Rural Development, ERHWSC was able to acquire a grant and loan combination, but the additional debt is still significant. In addition the Board of Directors has approved the consistent purchase of additional Rio Grande River water rights as they become available


through development, and the construction of a larger more cost effective elevated water tower. It is the goal of the Board of Directors to be prepared for a severe drought scenario fully occurring and having an alternative supply to the current irrigation district. Two of ERHWSC's capital projects provide for this by establishing access to secondary sources and increasing current supply of water for our existing members.

ERHWSC continues to strive to improve our service and water quality to our members, while minimizing expenses at every opportunity. 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
