COMMISSION STAFF'S FINAL RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest and files this Final Recommendation.

I. BACKGROUND

On March 13, 2018, the City of Los Fresnos (City) and East Rio Hondo Water Supply Corporation (ERHWSC) (collectively, Applicants) filed an application with the Public Utility Commission (Commission) for approval of a service area contract under Tex. Water Code § 13.248 (TWC), to amend City's Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 11554 and ERHWSC's CCN No; 11552) in Cameron County, Texas. Specifically, the Applicants seek single certification in CCN service areas where they are currently dually certificated. Additionally, one small service area with no existing customers, which is singly certificated to the City will be transferred to WSC.

Order No.4 required that Staff shall file a final recommendation on or before October 8, 2018. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. STAFF'S FINAL RECOMMENDATION

Staff has reviewed the application and recommends that this application for a CCN amendment be approved. As supported by the memorandum of Gregory Charles of the Water Utility Regulation Division at Attachment A, Staff recommends that the application be found to comply with the criteria outlined for CCN amendments in the Texas Water Code § 13.248 (TWC). In accordance with this recommendation, the corresponding map (Attachment B) and certificates (Attachment C) were consented by the Applicants on September 25, 2018. On or before October

1

15, 2018, the parties will jointly proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law and ordering paragraphs. Staff further recommends that the Applicants file certified copies of the CCN map along with a written description of the CCN service area in the county clerk's office pursuant to TWC §§ 13.257(r)-(s).

III. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests that the ALJ issue an order consistent with the above recommendations.

On March 13, 2018, the City of Los Fresnos (City) and East Rio Hondo Water Supply Corporation (ERHWSC), (Collectively, Applicants) filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas for approval of a service area contract under Texas Water Code § 13.248 (TWC), to amend Certificates of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) Nos. 11554 (City) and 11552 (ERHWSC) in Cameron County, Texas. Specifically, the Applicants seek single certification in CCN service areas where they are currently dually certificated. Additionally, one small service area with no existing customers which is singly certificated to the City will be transferred to the ERHWSC.

Proof of Notice sent to affected parties subject to the transaction was filed on July 18, 2018.

The application meets all of the statutory requirements of TWC Chapter 13 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Chapter 24 rules and regulations. Staff recommends approval of the application.

The Applicants consented to the attached maps and certificates on September 25, 2018.

Based on the above information, Staff recommends the Commission do the following:

- Issue an order approving the application;
- Provide the attached maps and certificates to the Applicants.

Staff further recommends that the Applicants file certified copies of the CCN maps along with a written description of the CCN service areas in the county clerk's office pursuant to TWC §§ 13.257 (r)-(s).




