**NOTICE FINDING THE APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT;  
AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Notice addresses Commission Staff's recommendation regarding the sufficiency of Oak Hill Estates Water Company's application for pass-through rate change. Commission Staff recommended that the application be deemed administratively incomplete and deficient. Staff recommended that Oak Hill be given until May 11, 2018 to cure the deficiencies. The Commission finds that Oak Hill's application is deficient and incomplete.

No later than May 11, 2018, Oak Hill shall provide new notice to customers as described by Commission Staff and file supplemental information to cure the deficiencies in the application. Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation on the sufficiency of the application no later than June 11, 2018.
