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

Estates Water Company for a Pass-Through Rate Change

NOTICE OF APPROVAL

This Notice addresses Castle Country Homes Inc. d/b/a Oak Hill Estates Water Company's (Castle Country's) application for a pass-through rate change due to an increase in well pumpage fees imposed on the utility by the North Harris County Regional Water Authority (NHCRWA). NHCRWA's increased the fee from \$2.90 per thousand gallons to \$3.40 effective April 1, 2018. Castle Country requests approval to increase the current pass-through charge of \$3.33 to \$3.90.

On June 11, 2018, Commission Staff recommended that the administrative law judge (ALJ) deem the supplemented application and revised notice sufficient. The ALJ deems the supplemented application and revised notice sufficient.

Commission Staff recommends the Commission approve a pass-through gallonage rate of \$3.90 per 1,000 gallons.

The Commission approves Castle Country's application and a pass-through rate of \$3.90 per 1,000 gallons to customers in the Oak Hill Estates subdivision. The revised tariff pages provided by Commission Staff are attached to this Notice.

THE RECONNECT FEE MUST BE PAID BEFORE SERVICE CAN BE RESTORED TO A CUSTOMER WHO HAS BEEN DISCONNECTED FOR THE FOLLOWING REASONS (OR OTHER REASONS LISTED UNDER SECTION 2.0 OF THIS TARIFF):

LINE EXTENSION AND CONSTRUCTION CHARGES:

REFER TO SECTION 3.0--EXTENSION POLICY FOR TERMS, CONDITIONS, AND CHARGES WHEN NEW CONSTRUCTION IS NECESSARY TO PROVIDE SERVICE.

PASS THROUGH PROVISION:

For Utilities subject to changes in costs imposed by any non-affiliated provider of purchased water or sewer or a groundwater conservation district having jurisdiction over the Utility, these increases (decreases) shall be passed though as an adjustment to the gallonage charge according to the formula:

R = G/(1-L), where:

R = new proposed pass through rate;

G = new gallonage charge by source supplier (per 1,000 gallons);

L = water line loss for preceding 12 months, not to exceed 0.15
