**COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR AN AMENDED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Request for an Amended Procedural Schedule.

**I. BACKGROUND**

On March 23, 2018, Aqua Texas, Inc. (Aqua Texas) filed an application to amend its water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 13203 for the provision of retail water utility service in Fort Bend County.

On June 12, 2018, Order No. 3 required Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs to the applicant for review and consent on or before August 13, 2018. Staff timely sent these items to the Applicant.

**II. REQUEST FOR AN AMENDED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

Pursuant to 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. The Applicant and Staff have been working to revise the tariff that was originally provided to the Applicant by Staff on or before August 13, 2018. In order to facilitate the further processing of this Application, Staff requests the following revised procedural schedule so that the Applicant has sufficient time to review the updated materials:

<b>Event</b>	<b>Date</b>
Deadline for Commission Staff to provide revised final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable), to the applicant for review and consent	August 31, 2018
Deadline for the applicant to file signed consent forms with the Commission	September 7, 2018

If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	September 14, 2018
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file joint proposed findings of fact, including findings that address the factors in Texas Water Code § 13.246(c) and conclusions of law	September 21, 2018

### **III. CONCLUSION**

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with the above request for an extension.




