COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON SUFFICIENCY OF NOTICE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest and files this Recommendation on Sufficiency of Notice.

I. BACKGROUND

On March 23, 2018, Aqua Texas Inc. (Aqua Texas) filed an application to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity number 13203 in Fort Bend County. Order No. 2 required that Staff file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice within 10 days of receiving proof of notice. Staff apologizes for this late filed pleading and any inconvenience caused by this delay.

II. STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON SUFFICIENCY OF NOTICE

On May 23, 2018, Aqua Texas filed its proof of notice with the Commission. Staff has reviewed the proof of notice. Staff recommends that the notice provided be found sufficient.

III. PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff proposes the following procedural schedule:

Notice completed	May 14, 2018
Deadline for intervention	June 13, 2018 ¹
Deadline for Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to the Applicant for review and consent	August 13, 2018

¹ Under 16 Tex. Admin. Code (TAC) § 24.106(a)(3), the intervention deadline is 30 days after the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later. The later of these dates in this instance is May 14, 2018, making the intervention deadline June 13, 2018.

Deadline for Applicant to file signed consent	August 27, 2018
forms with the Commission	
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Staff to	September 3, 2018
file a recommendation on final disposition	
If no hearing is requested, deadline for the	September 10, 2018
Applicant to file a response to Staff's	
recommendation on final disposition. If no	
response is filed, the parties shall file a joint	
proposed notice of approval.	

IV. CONCLUSION

For the reasons discussed above, Staff recommends that Aqua Texas' proof of notice be found sufficient and that the proposed procedural schedule be adopted.
