This Order addresses Commission Staff's July 2, 2018, recommendation that the administrative law judge (ALJ) find the provision of notice sufficient. Applicants filed proof of notice on May 22, 2018, and fully completed notice on May 16, 2018; therefore, the 120-day deadline to approve the sale administratively or require a public hearing is October 13, 2018. Commission Staff proposed a procedural schedule based on that deadline.

The ALJ deems the notice sufficient. The following procedural schedule shall apply:

Event	Date
Deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing or file a recommendation on approval of the sale and on the certificate of convenience and necessity amendment	July 20, 2018
Deadline for parties to file a response to Commission Staff's recommendation	August 3, 2018
120-day deadline for Commission to approve the sale or require a hearing	October 13, 2018
