**ORDER NO. 4  
FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND  
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE FOR CONTINUED PROCESSING**


This Order addresses the April 10, 2018, application to amend water and sewer certificates of convenience and necessity. Stanley Lake Municipal Utility District filed affidavits and copies of notice on July 23, 2018 attesting that it completed notice. Commission Staff recommends that the administrative law judge (ALJ) find the provision of notice sufficient and adopt the proposed procedural schedule.

The ALJ finds the notice sufficient and adopts the proposed procedural schedule as follows:

Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable), to the applicant for review and consent	September 4, 2018
Deadline for the applicant to file signed consent forms with the Commission	September 18, 2018
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	September 25, 2018
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file a joint proposed notice of approval including detailed findings of fact, corresponding conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs	October 2, 2018
